


## A TITANIC COVER?

A TITANIC COVER? continued from P. 1.

Marty Longseth has submitted a photocopy of this cover from another collector. His question: "Do you know if TITANIC carried mail on her maiden westbound trip?" The cover illustrated on P. 1 was posted at Paulx on March 13, 1912 and backstamped Paris Mar. 14. It is addressed to Washington, D.C. and backstamped Mar. 27. Where was the marking TITANIC and 273938 applied? What is the significance of the number? The dates appear to be in the proper time frame. Can any member share more light on this item?
