Reverse bears the Washington receiver pmk of March 18 1912. This cover was expected to be carried on the Titanic on her 20th March Maiden voyage, however the great liner was not ready and sailed later. Although specially cacheted, the mail contracts did not allow the White Star office to hold this cover until Titanic arrived at Cherbourg, instead it had to be sent onboard the Olympic. This is a very elusive item, the last example we offered (2001) sold for £2600.
