The Royal Mail Steamer Titanic was scheduled to call at the port of Cherbourg on its maiden voyage. Had the steamer been built on schedule it would have arrived at Cherbourg March 20th. However the final elements of construction were delayed, and were instead carried by the steamer "Main". (Image)
